We have had much to celebrate this year, including:

Rockwood Citizen Rewards Evening

At the end of this term, we have held a successful event where we invited a select group of pupils and parents to celebrate their positive behaviour and attendance in school. We are committed to excellent standards of personal effort and behaviour and this starts with strong attendance to school.

Combined Cadet Force (CCF)

Our Cadets have had a great year, many have completed Syllabus Star Level Tests. We have had 2 week long camps, the first being at Feb half term at the Altcar Training Camp in Liverpool, then the Summer Camp at Bramcote Cadet Training Centre in Nuneaton and weekend camps in both areas.

Half Term Camp: was Syllabus Training where the cadets were taught Fieldcraft, Skill At Arms completing their Weapons Handling Tests and Shooting Test.

Summers Camp: was Adventurous Training based where we went to Thorpe Park, Spring Lakes AT Centre where they did water sports, raft building and an inflatable obstacle course on the water, as well as days out at Warwick and Stratford visiting Historical Locations.

Most weekend Training: was Navigation and Expedition Training, where the Cadets as a team require navigating themselves in an array of different terrains from urban to rural areas.

We are looking forward to the next year with similar training possibly at different venues.

This was a fantastic opportunity attended by all of our CCF cadets.

Activities included training on the cadet rifles, first aid training, weapons handling tests conducted.
