**Teachers' Industrial Action – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

As you may be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) has voted in favour of industrial action by their teaching members. The third of these national strikes takes place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023. We are now able to confirm plans for all students.
