Teachers' Industrial Action – Wednesday 1st February 2023

As you may be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) has voted in favour of industrial action by their teaching members. The first of these national strikes takes place on Wednesday 1st February 2023. We are now in a position to confirm plans for all students on Wednesday 1st February:

- Year 11 students should attend as normal, arriving by 8.30am and will complete a bespoke timetable. The year 11 Geography trip will take place as planned. Correspondence has been issued for the trip.
- Students in Year 11 who are sitting their Digital Information Technology public examination on the morning of 1st February 2023 should be ready to succeed in this examination.
- Students in Years 7-10 will receive remote learning through our well-established remote education provision, following the timetable below. These students should not attend school.
