Teachers' Industrial Action – Wednesday 1st March 2023

As you may be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) has voted in favour of industrial action by their teaching members. The second of these national strikes takes place on **Wednesday 1st March 2023**. We are now in a position to confirm plans for all students on Wednesday 1st March 2023:

- Year 11 and 10 students should attend as normal, arriving by 8.30am and will follow their normal timetable.
- Students in Years 7-9 will receive remote learning through our well-established remote education provision, following the timetable below.
