Year 10 GCSE Formal Mock Examinations Commencing 12th June 2023

Year 10 mock examinations are scheduled from Monday 12th June 2023 to Friday 30th June 2023. - The results of any mock examinations will be distributed before the end of the academic year and will also help to inform grade predictions for their final year of study at Rockwood Academy
- It is very important that every student is fully equipped for the examinations. We would expect your child to have the correct equipment all in a clear pencil case
