Firstly, thank you for your support throughout the Year 10 Mock Examinations. It is a time where students are tested in both their academic skills and knowledge but also their emotional resilience. We saw dedicated revision and a great approach to their examinations.

We are sending students results home on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2023. These reports will have both a current working at grade and an attitude to learning. We are only halfway through the GCSE courses, and this has been reflected in their grades. There will be mixed feelings with some students being disappointed with the grade they have achieved. This summer is the perfect time for students to close knowledge gaps and consolidate their learning ready for a strong start in September.

To support this, teachers have provided work and links to support summer study. These links are available on both the Academy website and the Year 10 MS Teams account. The second mark awarded students is their attitude to learning mark.
