You may be aware that our drama teacher resigned last term from her post to explore new pastures, and we wish her the best in her endeavours. After Miss Brown left, we have been unable to recruit a replacement of the high standard we, and you, rightly expect. Recruiting staff has always been a delicate matter and is one that has been exacerbated by COVID. We appreciate this may be disappointing to some, but we do not believe it is right to compromise on the quality of education your child receives.
